

Local Notice to Mariners 08-2023

Sovereign Harbour AIRBOURNE – EASTBOURNE INTERNATIONAL AIR SHOW – GENERAL INFORMATION

Airbourne 2023 operates between Thursday 17th August and Sunday 20th August. Historically, the event brings increased lock use and high numbers of vessels on the water.

The below information might be helpful to manage your time afloat this year:

As per previous years, there is an exclusion zone afloat marked with yellow buoys running parallel to the shore. **Vessels wishing to anchor must be 50m seaward of the yellow buoys.**

No swimmers or vessels (including jet ski's and paddle sports) are permitted in the exclusion zone (shaded area as shown).

Safety and control cover afloat for this year is provided by vessel MAGIC, contactable on VHF CH73.

Additional Lock Packers and Lock Keepers are on duty over each of the four days. Please ensure you follow their directions at all times. Visible boat names, having your radio on (CH17), and being prepared with lines and fenders both sides will help us get you in and out as quickly as possible.

Both locks will be in use and will follow the usual schedule of closing behind you on the hour and half hour unless traffic dictates both locks in the same direction, announcements will be broadcast on CH17.

Green / White / Green lights on the lock indicate Lock Packing is in force. You MUST take direction from either the Lock Packer or via VHF.

Red flashing lights indicate a top up, at that time we will be down to one lock only.
